

Chabad Hebrew School Pandemic Protocols

Chabad adheres to all mandatory requirements from the CDC as well as many of the suggested practices. Following these rules can mitigate the risks but it does not eliminate the risk of COVID-19.

DROP OFF/PICK UP

- All drop off and pick up will be done curbside. Parents are asked not to enter the building unless absolutely necessary.



ILLNESS

- We will be taking the temperature of every staff & worker before they enter the building with a Non Contact Thermometer.

Students will be asked to remain in their car until their temperature is taken. Anyone that has a temperature of 100 or more will be asked to go home.

- If a child or teacher tests positive for COVID19, that class will be closed for the next 14 days.
- If a child or staff has close contact with someone that tests positive for Covid-19, then they will need to be quarantined for 14 days.



MASKS

- Staff & students must wear face coverings- we will have extra available if necessary

SANITIZATION

- Sanitizing daily in all bathrooms and other high touch areas, such as door knobs



DISTANCING:

- Students will be assigned places in each classroom space that are 6 feet apart
- Each child will have his/her own assigned seat, supply boxes and are asked NOT to bring anything from home except for a backpack and a snack.

FOOD

- If there is an activity that includes food, staff will use gloves and masks when distributing.



HAND WASHING

- Staff and students must follow rigorous handwashing procedures as detailed by Ohio Law.
- Arrival of the day
- After using the restroom
- After outdoor play
- When visibly soiled
- Prior to departure
- Before eating and after eating
